Live and Learn in Kenya NGO is a privately run non-government organization for needy children and youths living in the slums of Nakuru, Kenya. Our goal is to change the lives of the children in our program and open a door to the future. These extremely impoverished children receive all that they need to go to school and stay healthy.

Sponsor a future! With just US \$ 360 per year your sponsored child receives everything that he/she needs to go to school: school fees, mandatory uniform and shoes, books, school supplies and a warm meal every day. A sponsor isn't just filling a tummy for the day. A sponsor helps children to learn to help themselves through education and training.

Our projects - Providing future

Our foster child project — Many of our program children are orphans — mostly AIDS orphans. To prevent them from having to live on the streets, we provide their grandparents, other family or tribe members who take the children in to live with them with blankets, and micro-credits in order to begin some sort of business to earn their own money. This is the true meaning of "learning to help oneself". The foster parents and the children are able to form a good and caring relationship without the worries of where the next meal is coming from.



School — Our program children attend public schools, vocational training schools, colleges and universities. The expenses are enormous. Whether the child is sponsored or not, every child is provided with all of the school necessities, including school fees. Although school fees are no longer demanded in the public elementary schools, the schools all demand some form of "material fees", which come to


about the same amount. We provide desks, chairs, school supplies and extra textbooks.

School Construction — In February 2014 LLK received a generous donation to buy land and to begin the construction of a school of our own. Beginning with an elementary school, we will be building an entire education center. The school officially opened with its first 2 classes in January 2015 and we plan to build a classroom every year - with your donations! Feed a Smile — is the motto of our feeding program for up to 500 children. The children receive a school lunch, but during school breaks and on weekends their parents usually do not know where the next meal is coming from. We provide these meals in a special way. With just US \$ 125 a nutritious, warm meal is provided for the children. The mothers take turns cooking, serving and cleaning up — and rejoicing the fact that their children are being taken care of and receive a meal themselves. These "meal parties" can be donated for different occasions, for example as a birthday, wedding, anniversary, etc. present. The children give the only thing that they can: a gift of prayer when they say grace for the person/people/firm being celebrated. A message can be written on the chalkboard, for example: "Happy Birthday Aunt Pat. All of these children are praying for your health and happiness!" Donors with an e-mail address receive photos of the children praying and eating and of the board message.

What a way to feed some smiles!

HIV/AIDS and Hygiene Awareness — We provide medical care for our program children, but to protect them and their parents from the most serious and contagious diseases we organize HIV/AIDS and Hygiene Awareness seminars for the youths and parents. Along with a wide range of information presented in a simple way by trained facilitators — pictures, stories, and video films — we provide sanitary supplies to the youths and adults. Private medical examinations and testing is also provided, along with self-help groups for parents and youths. Our "Aid for AIDS" project caters to HIV-positive parents, so that they can live and watch their children grow.
