2025 ANNUAL REPORT

In the year 2025, we had several activities that we undertook. Below we have some of these activities; the year was very tough for us. We had a lot to do for our project but with limited resources. But at the end the year, we were able to complete most of the things we had planned. We paid school fees for all our children in high school, colleges and University. All children received a warm meal every day of the week and our children at LLK School received all they needed for learning. Both children and their parents received their Christmas presents before we closed our project on 20th, December 2025.

a) Auditing

We started the year by preparing for auditing of our 2024 accounts at the beginning of the year. First was the annual report then audit of accounts. It is a government requirement for all PBOs (Public Benefit Organizations) to present their books of account by June the following year. By end of February, we had submitted our Audit and annual reports to both the government and our sponsors.

b) Form 4 Results

In 2024, we had 13 students who sat for form 4 final exams. Out of this number, 6 students passed their exams and they will be joining University by the end of this year. 7 will be joining colleges to study different trades.

c) Visitors from Germany

On 6th, February, we received guests from Germany. Nobert Podschlapp and family visited our school. This is the third consecutive year they visited our school. They love celebrating Nobert's wife birthday from our school. These guests came with lots of blessings for our school and children. Other than coming to see our school and the computer lab they sponsored, they came with games kits for our children. They also came with candies for our children.

During their visit, they asked us what they can assist our school with. I proposed that they help in our Day Care construction. When they went back to Germany,

they donated 10,000€ towards construction of the Day care. We were very grateful for their support.

d) Day Care construction

We started our Day care construction in March 2025. In 2025, we didn't have a Day care class. The former Day care was occupied by grade 9. This necessitated the construction of a new Day care classroom. By end of July, the classroom and its toilets were completed and ready to use. They were officially opened on 14th, November 2025.

f) University admission

In 2024, we had 13 students who sat for form 4 exams. Out of 13, 6 qualified for university while the 7 joined middle level colleges.

At the beginning of September, 4 students joined universities to study different courses. Moses Mwaura will be studying BSC in Electronics Engineering, Britney Salano Bachelor of Education, Edwin James Obanda BSC in Statistics and Joyce Akinyi will be studying Criminology. We paid all required costs for all of them.

g) PP1 and Day Care of 2026 Intake

As mentioned above, in 2025, we didn't have a Day Care class. We are planning to have it come 2026. In September' we had a double intake, PP1 and Day Care of 2026. PP1 were admitted on 22nd while Day care was admitted on 29th.

As from 5th, January 2026, they will all report to school to start their academic journey. I wish them all the best as they start their journey.

h) Annual sponsors visit

On 6th, November 2025, we received 21 guests from Germany and Canada. They were on their annual visit to monitor our project.

It was during this visit that we officially opened the Day care classroom. This was done on 14th, November 2025. These guests also donated money and bought food stock for our feeding program. On behalf of our children, we are very grateful. They stayed for 10 working days.

i) Micro-credit

Micro credit is an integral program in our project. Parents/guardians are given seed money to start an income generating activity. They receive this money from

children sponsors most of them through Renate Oberdiek who in most cases mobilize funds from sponsors in Germany. Some of businesses parents do are fruits and vegetable selling, food kiosks, charcoal selling, chicken keeping, salon among others.

The purpose of this program is to help parents help themselves. We visit these businesses every after 3 month for monitoring and evaluation. The last time we visited them was in November 2025. During the visit, we noticed that most of them are doing well. Most parents in this group are able to get profit which makes them to meet their basic household requirements. This was the objective of this project. At the moment, we have more than 100 parents doing income generating activities. We are hoping that more will also get funds in 2026.
